Trustees poised to approve budget

 fund balance to balance the budget, it's never been touched. The fund balance keeps rising."

"It's just building," Welch said. "We need to use some of it, or at least try to use some of it, so it just doesn't keep growing, because it's not fair for certain taxpayers who pay these taxes and then it's not used in their lifetime," Longwell said.

"That's why we don't want to increase taxes, either; we don't really need to," Welch said.

"Some of the assessments went up, so we're actually going to get more revenue from taxes than we did last year, because assessments went up on certain properties," Longwell said.

Total revenues are projected to increase by about \$300,000.

Under the state's tax increase threshold, the village could raise the property tax rate to \$8.10. Doing that would result in an estimated \$52,946 in additional revenue.

But Welch said, "Sooner or later, we've got to knock that fund balance down, because we



just can't keep approving all that money. And we don't want to raise taxes if we have sufficient funds to cover our budget."

Rates for sewer (\$4.79 per 100 cubic feet of usage) and water (\$3.95) are projected to remain the same.

Trustees will likely decide on

the 2022-23 budget at Monday's work session, which begins at 6 p.m. There will be a public hearing on the budget proposal prior to any vote.
