

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, April 11, to Sunday, April 17, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 207 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, April 11

- **100 block of N. Fourth Street, assist** – Caller to 911 reported juveniles on the basketball court in the early morning hours, number of subjects unknown. Patrol responded and found no juveniles in the area.
