

The following activity occurred Monday, March 15, to Sunday, March 21, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 178 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

- Monday, March 15**
