

'Big R': ESS returns to Ransomville for 'King of the Hill' on Sept. 17

The long-running "King of the Hill" at the Ransomville Speedway will add another chapter to the history books of the event in 2021. The Sept. 17 racing program will feature the return of the Empire Super Sprints along with the opening of rules for the

street stock "King of the Hill." For the first time since 2009, the Empire Super Sprints will make their triumphant return to Ransomville. Past series champion Jason Barney won the race back in 2009. Mike VanDusen won the inaugural visit in 1988 and repeated in 1989. John Bi-

rosch and Tom Tabor each won three ESS events, with Lance Younge and Craig Keel winning on two occasions each. Phil Mott, George Suprick III, Rob Dietrick and Steve Dow each have one Ransomville victory in ESS competition.

County assists Youngstown



Earlier this summer, First District Niagara County Legislator Irene Myers visited with Village of Youngstown Mayor Raleigh Reynolds and trustees to deliver a \$10,000 check to benefit Niagara River shoreline repairs. The contribution represents Niagara County's share of Niagara River Greenway funding toward the Youngstown Water Street Shoreline Stabilization and Mitigation project.

With a total project cost of \$2.103 million under the New York State Resiliency and Economic Development Initiative, the project is intended to address areas impacted by earlier flooding problems in the lower river areas. Funding is expected to go toward property damage concerns, namely installation of floating docks and jetties in the river to safeguard boating activity and correct shoreline erosion.
