

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, July 19, to Friday, July 30, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, July 19

- **4700 block of Porter Center Road, assist** – Caller to 911 requested guests to be removed from an airbnb rental. Caller said five to six occupants were involved and the complaint "was a long story." Patrol responded and advised the guests their airbnb contract was terminated. Guests were in the process of leaving with the remaining guests to vacate after cleaning was completed. Patrol cleared.
- **800 block of Oriole Lane, suspicious activity** – Caller to 911 reported a male in a red shirt, black jacket and pants walking around the area, attempting to open the doors on parked vehicles. Male seen driving a vehicle, possibly silver; two additional subjects exiting vehicle and trying the door handles of other nearby vehicles. No items reported missing by caller.
