

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Saturday, July 18, to Sunday, July 26, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported more than 225 response calls during this period. ### Saturday, July 18

- **Ridge Road/Niagara Scenic Parkway, vehicle/traffic stop** – Driver cited for failure to obey a traffic control device. Patrol reported the driver passed through a solid red light. Uniform traffic tickets issued for Lewiston Town Court.
- **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital, assist public** – Patrol advised of a fight between two subjects in the hospital detox unit. One party left the hospital on foot; the other involved party did not wish to talk to patrol.
