## Board sets public hearing on LMK Associates PUD

No action was taken, with further discussion expected at the board's final audit/year-end meeting on Thursday, Dec. 30.

Lannon also said the town waterline project was nearly complete, and CSX railroad officials were finalizing bore work on properties adjacent to project.

"They are completing the bore under the CSX railroad as we speak, and they are hoping that last segment will be done by the end of this week, weather-permitting," Lannon said.

Town Councilman Rob Morreale reported Baylor Solar submitted an application package for a community solar project eyed for 2660 Saunders Settlement Road.

"They requested the Town Board authorize GHD ... to initiate a long-form SEQR review," Morreale said.

The board went on to approve the matter without comment.

Morreale also reported the Planning Board reviewed a conceptual plan and rezoning request for a planned unit de-

velopment requested by LMK Associates LLC on a property located at Northridge Drive and Ridge Road. Morreale requested the board approve a public hearing on the matter, to be held at 6 p.m. Dec. 30 at the board's final regular meeting.

Recreation Director Mike Dashineau said the Lewiston Family Ice Rink survived the Saturday windstorm. Overall attendance at the rink has been strong thus far.

"The rink has been busy; we've done some repairs," Dashineau said. He noted 800 masks have been distributed to users and visitors.

The ice rink will remain open to Jan. 3, 2022.

Jacoby reported LPD Capt. Joshua Caine completed his final day with the department on Dec. 10. He sought board approval for the promotion of LPD part-time officer Colin Cain to full-time. The latter's name was taken from the Civil Service list.

The board approved the move.
