

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Saturday, July 4, to Thursday, July 9, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported more than 220 response calls during this period. Saturday, July 4

- **600 block of Sara Court, damage to property** – Officer initiated call. Patrol notified the homeowner that their mailbox was taken apart and in the street. Homeowner suspected juveniles causing problems in the area. Patrol assisted resident on repair. Later, patrol advised that the mailbox was damaged again. Officers searched area with negative results.
- **5500 block of Walmore Road, fire** – Caller to 911 reported a possible trailer on fire near a gas/convenience business. Patrol confirmed the trailer was fully involved.
