√ Saturday, June 26: "Art of Clay," featuring soapstone carving for kids. Preregistration is required and limited to 20 registrants per session. Guests will learn the basic techniques of stone and antler sculpture from renowned antler carver Hayden Hanes.

√ Saturday, July 3: "Art of Paint," featuring acoustic storytelling and Tonemah. The award-winning Tuscarora singer-songwriter will share stories from experiences and relationships he has forged along his journey.

√ Saturday, July 10: "Art of Water," featuring antler and bone uses of the Haudenosaunee. Guests will learn the basic techniques of bone and antler sculpture from Hanes.

√ Saturday, July 17: "Art in Motion," featuring wampum belts (display, history, demonstration and workshops) and guest speaker Dr. Richard Hamell.

√ Saturday, July 24: "Art Illuminated," featuring Kehala Smith. Cornhusk doll workshop and teachings, plus "Art of Haudenosaunee Dance" performance with Jordan Smith.

√ Saturday, July 31: "Art of Animals," featuring traditional master storyteller Perry Ground; Haudenosaunee stories: "Tricky Fox and other Animal Tales," "Powerful Women."

√ Saturday, Aug. 7: "Art of Disguise," featuring a stone-

carving demonstration with Haynes.

√ Saturday, Aug. 14: "Art of Sound," featuring wampum belts display, Haudenosaunee Four Sacred Direction and Mother Earth beading workshop with Hamel.

√ Saturday, Aug. 21: "Art of Monsters," featuring "Branche" by Cirque Barcode. Also: stories from the Haudenosaunee "Life in a Longhouse Village," "Hero and Heroine Tales."
