



Niagara Falls goes blue & gold for bent curve

Gov. Andrew Cuomo on Sunday announced landmarks across New York state would be lit in blue and gold in honor of New Yorkers' work to flatten the curve of the coronavirus. Niagara Falls was among the landmarks shining bright.

"We have come a long way in the fight against COVID-19 and a lot of people have suffered to get here, but what we have done together was extraordinary," Cuomo said. "Forget flattening the curve of the virus - we bent the curve - and New Yorkers should be proud of their accomplishment. In light of that, we are going to highlight the landmarks across the state in blue and gold in honor of our New Yorkers, because we are New York tough, smart, united, disciplined and loving."

On Saturday, Cuomo announced the state had reached the lowest number of hospitalizations and deaths since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic. The number of total hospitalizations was down last Friday to 2,603 from a record-high of 18,825 during the peak of the pandemic, and 35 people in New York passed away due to COVID-19, down from a record-high of 800 just eight weeks ago.

Up in Youngstown, area businesses, including the Youngstown Village Diner, The Ontario House (Stone Jug), Bandana's and Main Street Pizza are now operating on a limited basis, with either on-premises outside services or takeout available. "While still just doing takeout, we will be providing tables and chairs for you to enjoy your

food hot and fresh while appreciating the great outdoors," the Youngstown Village Diner said on its Facebook page. "As usual, call and order your food and grab a table! Or ... grab a table, order your food and enjoy a beverage while you wait. Tables are socially distanced and span the storefronts on our side of the street. Can't wait to see you on the street!" "We're open!" said Melissa

Kudel, co-owner of Bandana's, as she invited visitors to come check out their new covered rear patio with bar and food services available. Rebecca Poletti at the Youngstown Galley said that her business remains closed until further notice. "No patio or takeout at this time." Over at Somewhere, owner Pat Stack said he was anticipating a reopening in the near fu-

ture, with events in planning for later this month. While at the Fish, Feather and Fur Conservation Society on Swann Road, the private sportsmen's club bar operations remains in shutdown mode for the time being. Each of these locations is expected to reopen more as the state's business restrictions ease.
