Shred-It event June 27



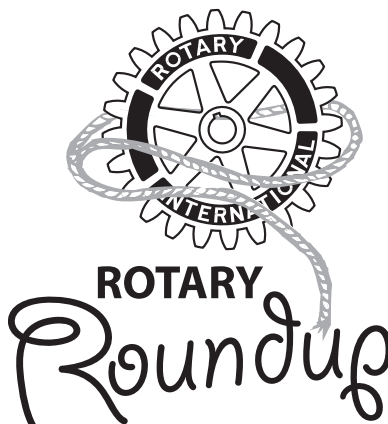

The event – sponsored by Christine A. Learman, CPA, PC – is a fundraiser supporting Rotary Club of Grand Island community projects.

Islandwide Clean-up this weekend

On Saturday, June 13, from 9 a.m. until noon, Grand Island residents are encouraged to mobilize their family members and pitch in to clean up their neighborhood or a surrounding property.

This Islandwide Clean-up Initiative encourages residents to clean up trash as part of an effort to further beautify the community. The event is rain or shine.

The initiative grew from the online posts of resident Debbie Whalen, who began her personal crusade of picking up trash along East River and the DEC Spicer Creek Park during the COVID-19 pandemic. Other Grand Islanders also began their own journeys by doing the same. Highway Superintendent Dick Crawford, Councilwoman Jenn Baney and Whalen brainstormed this initiative to include all Grand Island businesses and Island residents, with the Grand Island Chamber of Commerce, Grand Island Rotary and the Grand Island Lions Club all stepping up to assist.

During this time, residents are encouraged to clean their homes and yards and dispose of excess trash, passenger car tires, and any items that could hold water and become a breeding ground for mosquitoes. Volunteers will be needed for some additional clean-up areas that have been identified. See the Town of Grand Island website for a list of clean-up areas.

Underage volunteers must be accompanied by an adult. Participants are encouraged to wear proper attire (gloves, work boots), sunscreen, and insect repellent; to stay hydrated; wear a mask if social distancing cannot be accomplished; and to be mindful of ticks.

The Grand Island Memorial Library will open to the public for limited service beginning Monday, June 15.

Library patrons are asked to take note of the following:

- All returns must go into the book drop.
- The library will not accept material donations (books, DVDs, etc.) until further notice. Services will include:
- Over-the-desk transactions including checkout, reference, and monetary transactions to pay for fines/fees.
- Computer use and printing, limited to 15-minute sessions.
- As always, wi-fi is available 24/7 for everyone. The network is BECPL2 and the password is librarywifi.

Curbside service will still be offered in addition during open hours:
