 (33.12%) and Christopher M. Mazur with 192 votes (24.37%). One write-in vote was cast (0.13%) for an unnamed candidate.

On the Democratic line, Faso scored 940 votes (47.81%) of the count. Mazur finished second with 520 votes (26.45%) while Saraceno was third with 506 (25.74%). No write-in votes were cast.

And on the Conservative line, Faso was again the winner, with 37 votes (52.86%) to 19 votes (27.14%) for Saraceno and 14 (20.00%) for Mazur. Again, there were no write-in votes in this race.

In other town/village races of note:

- John Syracuse won the ballot on the Republican line for Newfane supervisor with 484 votes (89.96%) to 54 (10.04%) for Troy D. Barnes. No write-in votes were cast.

- Susan L. Neidlinger was the top votegetter on the Republican ticket for two seats on the Newfane Town Council with 411 cast (44.63%). Rick Coleman scored 376 votes (40.83%) and Charles K. Stodolka took third with 132 votes (14.33%). There were two write-in votes (0.22%, unspecified).

- Scott R. Boudeman won the Newfane town justice seat on the GOP line with 423 votes (81.66%) to 95 (18.34%) for Andrew R. Johnson III. There were no write-in votes.

Boudeman also took the Conservative line for Newfane town justice with 32 votes (88.89%) to three (8.33%) for Johnson III. There was one write-in vote (2.78% cast, unspecified).

- In Wilson, Maria T. Evans won the town justice race on the GOP line with 246 votes (60.89%), to 156 (38.61%) for Nancy M. Schaal Simmons. There were two write-in votes (0.50%, unspecified).

Wrapping up, in Niagara County Legislature races of note:

- Jeffrey Elder won the Democratic line in District 4 with 258 votes (51.09%). Owen T. Sneed followed with 247 (48.91%). No write-in votes were cast.

Elder won the Working Families line in District 4 with four votes (100%) cast, to zero votes for Nicholas J. Pasceri. No write-in votes were cast.

- Christopher P. Voccio won the Republican line for District 6 with 110 votes cast (56.99%). Timothy E. Huether Sr. followed with 83 votes (43.01%). No write-in votes were cast.

- In District 9, Joseph H. Kissel was the top votegetter on the Working Families line with 28 votes (54.90%). There were 20 write-in votes (39.22%) for unnamed candidates. Daniel J. Carny had three votes (5.88%).

- David E. Godfrey was the top votegetter on the GOP line in District 10 with 584 votes (64.18%) Trevor J. Ganshaw followed with 325 votes (35.71%). There was one write-in vote (0.11%).
