

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Feb. 28, to Sunday, March 6, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 253 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Feb. 28

- **1500 block of Saunders Settlement Road, alarm burglary** – Alarm provider reported a residential alarm in a garage; call later cancelled.
- **Mount Hope/Green roads, traffic complaint** – Caller to 911 reported a grey Jeep, no plates, occupied by two, possible road rage incident. Driver reportedly not letting the male driver in a red Dodge Santa Fe drive down the roadway. Patrols responded.
