Sutherland's Legacy

Community advocate Lee Simonson said, "Col. Bruce Sutherland left a legacy of community and national service."

A Lewiston native, Sutherland attended Lewiston-Porter and excelled at sports. He married his high school sweetheart, Jacqueline "Jackie" Foss, on Aug. 24, 1968. Sutherland graduated from Niagara County Community Col-

lege, and the State University of New York at Geneseo, with a degree in biology. He also obtained a master's degree in management from the University of Southern California.

After college, Sutherland joined the Air Force and enrolled in officer training school where he became a pilot. During his decorated 26-year Air Force career, Sutherland and his family were assigned to far-flung locations across the U.S. and world, including the Philippines and Panama. He flew aircraft including the T-37, C-130, the B-1 bomber and the B-52 Stratofortress. His military service culminated in his promotion to colonel and his appointment as wing commander at Dyess, a major Air Force base in Abilene, Texas,

which is part of the Global Strike Command. After retiring from the Air Force, Sutherland became a captain for a major airline.

He and Jackie returned to Lewiston in 2002 and Bruce became active with several civic organizations, including the Lewiston VFW Downriver Post 7487. He was the highest-ranking veteran in Lewiston history and led the effort to establish a scholarship fund.

Sutherland was serving as president of the Lewiston Library board of trustees. He was a former president of the Lewiston Historical Association and served on the Fort Niagara board of directors. He was appointed and later elected as a Lewiston village trustee where he served for several years.
