## Lewiston GardenFest now accepting applications for vendors & open gardens

Theme for June 18 & 19 event is 'Helping Lewiston bloom for 95 years'

Lewiston GardenFest is now recruiting both vendors and residents interested in showcasing their own gardens for this year's event on Saturday, June 18, and Sunday, June 19. The Lewiston Garden Club presents the event.

"It's a wonderful time to celebrate our local gardens as Lewiston Garden Club marks its 95th anniversary and Lewiston gears up for its bicentennial this summer," said Judy Talarico, chair, Lewiston GardenFest. "We've been helping Lewiston bloom for 95 years, and are excited to showcase our love of gardening with the entire community at this year's Lewiston GardenFest by sharing plenty of new ideas to spark inspiration for your own green spaces."

Businesses and vendors who

sell items related to gardening, horticulture and the outdoors – including nurseries, landscapers, garden artists and others – are encouraged to apply. Vendor applications are due by May 1 and can be downloaded at [lewistongardenfest.com](http://lewistongardenfest.com). The application fee varies from \$125 to \$225 based on the size of the vendor display.

Village and Town of Lewiston residents who are interested in showcasing their own gardens are encouraged to be part of Lewiston GardenFest's open gardens. Festival attendees can view the participating gardens only when the "Open Garden" signs are in place between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. during the event weekend. Located along Center Street, Lewiston GardenFest is free to attend and also includes speakers demonstrating new and different techniques to enhance one's gardens, master gardeners on hand to answer questions throughout the weekend, and garden-related craft activities for children. ### Earth Day Cleanup at Wilson-Tuscarora Park

The Niagara County Central Rotary and the Wilson Central District announced the second annual Earth Day cleanup will take place from 8 a.m. to noon, Saturday, April 23, at Wilson-Tuscarora State Park's Roosevelt Beach.

The Great Lakes Watershed Cleanup initiative is an effort that has grown from a District 7090 service project covering a small portion of Lake Ontario and Erie to a multidistrict plan to focus Rotarians' attention to all five of the Great Lakes, the streams and the waterways feeding them. The Rotary Club's goal is to support this local cleanup event to coincide annually with Earth Day on the Great Lakes Watershed.

Fifty-two years after the first Earth Day in 1970, the Niagara County Central Rotary will join fellow volunteers equipped with bags, gloves and trash grabbers. Come rain or shine, the team will celebrate community, work together to make a difference, and help to protect the environment.

"We are very fortunate to have such an amazing natural resource in our backyard. This is a great way to educate the public about the effects of littering, the importance of recycling, and instill a sense of stewardship about our planet," said Niagara County Central Rotary Club President, Dan Ljiljanich, who also serves as superintendent of the Niagara Wheatfield School District.
