the consultant and provide feedback on drafts.

Mayor Anne Welch said, "The Village of Lewiston covers approximately one square mile along the Lower Niagara River with a beautiful waterfront park, boat-launching facilities, residential boat slips and other amenities that allow picnicking, pleasure and commercial boating, and world-class fishing. It is also home to the Whirlpool Jet Boat and the Artpark Performing Arts Center. These attractions alone draw thousands of visitors and residents every year. Lewiston also has a vibrant and walkable commercial area, many historic buildings and sites, recreational parks, and bike trails. Adopting the Local Waterfront Revital-

ization Program will serve as a guideline and will further advance our goals to protect, promote and enhance our waterfront, business district, historic district, parks and recreation."

The Department of State's LWRP, funded under Title 11 of the EPF, provides matching grants on a competitive basis to eligible villages, towns, cities and counties located along New York's coasts or designated inland waterways for planning, design and construction projects to revitalize communities and waterfronts. The DOS Office of Planning, Development and Community Infrastructure works in partnership with waterfront communities across the state through the LWRP, focusing on protecting natural and cultural resources, expanding public access opportunities and strengthening the local economy. This program helps communities breathe new life into their underused waterfront assets in ways that ensure successful and sustainable revitalization.

## St. Joseph's Day Table at Marjim Manor

In observance of St. Joseph's Day on Saturday, March 19, the Winery at Marjim Manor will host a St. Joseph's Table from noon to 4 p.m. at its Lake Road winery in Appleton.

Hosted by Margo Sue Bittner of the Winery at Marjim Manor, residents are invited to join in the traditional celebration of St. Joseph's Day.

"According to tradition, there was a famine in Sicily, Italy. For relief, the residents prayed to their patron saint, St. Joseph. The hardship ended with rain for the crops. To celebrate, a feast was prepared and enjoyed by all," Bittner said.

"Today, St. Joseph's Day traditions include preparing an altar with a statue of St. Joseph, lilies,



candles and special foods. Dark yellow, brown and green are colors associated with St. Joseph's Day; however, in the United States, red is often used. That is

to contrast St. Joseph's Day with St. Patrick's Day.

"Traditionally, the meal is meatless. Pastas, bread, bean dishes, and almond cookies are among the traditional foods. St. Joseph was a carpenter, so to represent sawdust, bread crumbs are often used in the foods."

"All are welcome to come and share in the meal," Bittner said. She noted that, for more than 60 years, Marjim Manor served as the summer home for the Sisters of St. Joseph.

"Those grateful for their blessings often bring donations of food or money for the Peanut Butter and Jelly Drive," she said.
