River Region adjusting to coronavirus

With news of the coronavirus dominating the headlines, announcements of states of emergency, cancellations, postponements and business adjustments have been continuing nonstop.

The following were announced this past week.

•The Town of Lewiston announced that, with the news of a local case of COVID-19 and the updated information that the peak of this pandemic is now up to 45 days away, Lewiston Town Hall and all related town buildings would be closed to the public.

Town Supervisor Steve Broderick said staffing would remain

at lower levels per an executive order from the governor, which means all town departments will have a staffer on hand to answer phone calls. Those who have a situation that requires immediate action are requested to the town at 754-8214.

Those having an emergency

are asked to call 911. The Lewiston Police Department is operating at 100% staffing and service.

Broderick advised that, "If you know of anyone, especially our elderly, that may need assistance please call the town. Even though our senior center is closed, we have staff on hand to assist and help. We are all concerned about the well-being of all our residents and we will do whatever we can, within our abilities, to help."

On a related note, Carol Jacobs, interim director of the Lewiston Senior Center, said seniors will be able to have their medicine delivered by the pharmacies they use if they are unable to visit the pharmacy for pickup.

•The Town of Porter announced Town Hall is closed until further notice due to circumstances with the coronavirus beyond town control. Limited staff will be present. In case of an emergency, call Town Hall at 745-3730 or the Highway Department at 791-3831.

Effective immediately, scheduled meetings of the Town Board, plus the town Planning Board, Zoning Board of Appeals and related meetings, will be cancelled until further notice.

The Town of Porter also announced that, by order of the Office of the New York State Unified Court System, the Town of Porter Justice Court would be closed until further notice. Defendants will be notified by mail of new appearance dates.

Finally, the town announced all Recreation Department yoga classes held at the Youngstown Red Brick School Village Center have been cancelled until further notice.

Other Cancellations

•Orleans Niagara BOCES has announced that, due to the restriction on activities, the NOS-BA (Niagara Orleans School Boards Association) prospective board member workshop, scheduled for March 28, will be cancelled.

•The Youngstown Lions Club has cancelled its Easter egg hunt next month in compliance with Cuomo's order limiting the size of groups to fewer than 10 people.

•The Lewiston Public Library will be closed indefinitely.

A press release said, "We will keep our patrons updated on further developments via Facebook and our website. Please note that any fines accrued during this period will be waived."

•Deposits for Food is suspended. Founder Angelo Sarkees said, "As you may know, over the past six years, Deposits for Food has collected 750,000 returnable containers and 100-200 tons of scrap metal. The receipts have gone to three Niagara County food pantries, most notably Community Missions and Heart, Love & Soul (also Care-N-Share in Ransomville). Due to the uncertainty of the COVID-19 virus, I have decided to suspend my collections for a few weeks."

He added, "I hope to resume these efforts sooner than later. Feel free to drop off your returnables at Porter Empty Returns in Ransomville (phone 791-1113), and you could donate them to D4F's account if you wish. ...
