Niagara Falls State Park seeks artists, lifeguards

Niagara Falls State Park and Arts Services Inc. (ASI) have released a call for artists to create a lenticular mural that will be part of the new welcome center plaza in the park. The welcome center is slated to open in May 2023.

A press release noted, "The Niagara Falls State Park Welcome Center will be the centerpiece to tell the story of Niagara Falls State Park and the Western New York region. In addition to a modern and efficient building, the interpretive content will be a compelling look at the past, present and future of

not only the state park, but of the greater Niagara Falls community and the important role it has played in history."

The large lenticular mural will be located on a blank wall on the side of what is to be a washroom facility, but it will face the main entrance area as thousands of people each day approach the welcome center, grand staircase, and the falls themselves.

•State Parks announced there will be lifeguard qualifiers for positions in the Niagara Region of State Parks.

Testing is required for anyone wishing to work as a lifeguard at any New York state park. It will take place from 4-8 p.m. Thursday, May 26, at Hamburg Middle School, 360 Division St.

Prior to employment, successful candidates must be at least 15 years of age and must furnish proof of completion of CPR for the professional; and completion of the American Red Cross 1994 revised lifeguard training, which includes first aid, with a certificate for the waterfront module or equivalent courses. Successful candidates will also need a physician's certification of adequate physical fitness, including a minimum base of 20/70 uncorrected in both eyes and be correctable to the 20/40 standard. Candidates tested at a vision level below 20/40 in either one or both eyes must correct to a minimum of 20/40.

Lifeguard positions in the Niagara Region will be available at Beaver Island, Woodlawn Beach, Evan-gola and Fort Niagara state parks.
