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Notice of Public Hearing on the Budget, Annual Meeting, Budget Vote and Election – Governor Cuomo Executive Order No. 202.26 on May 1, 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Grand Island Central School District (the "District") of the Town of Grand Island, Erie County, New York, will hold a Budget Hearing. Said Hearing shall be held for the purpose of presentation and discussion of the 2020-2021 District budget and shall be held on Tuesday, May 26, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., Prevailing Time, remotely via Google Hangouts per the Executive Order No. 202.26, in the High School Professional Development Room, 1100 Ransom Road, Grand Island, New York.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Annual District Meeting, Election and Budget Vote will be held on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Prevailing Time, in the High School Gym, 1100 Ransom Road, Grand Island, New York, which vote will be on the following:

1. To elect two (2) at-large members to the Board of Education as follows:

a. Two (2) individuals to occupy three-year terms for the seats currently occupied by Ashli Dreher and Susan Marston. The terms will commence July 1, 2020 after expiration on June 30, 2020 of the terms of the above named Board Members, and will expire on June 30, 2023.

2. The adoption of the following propositions:

PROPOSITION NO. 1:
To adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2020-2021.

PROPOSITION NO. 2:
To adopt the following resolution:

RESOLVED: (a) That the Board of Education of the Grand Island Central School District, in the County of Erie, New York (the "District"), is hereby authorized to acquire various school buses

and vehicles, and to expend therefor an amount not to exceed \$685,000; (b) that a tax is hereby voted in the amount of not to exceed \$685,000 to finance such cost, such tax to be levied and collected in installments in such years and in such amounts as shall be determined by said Board of Education; (c) that the District is authorized to issue serial bonds to finance all or part of said cost, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said bonds as the same shall become due and payable; and (d) that, in lieu of bonds, the District is authorized to enter into one or more installment purchase contracts for the purchase of some or all of said buses and vehicles, for a term of not to exceed five (5) years; and a tax is hereby voted to pay each installment on any such contract.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that all candidates for the office of members of the Board of Education shall be self-nominated by petition per the Executive Order No. 202.26. Each petition shall be directed to the District Clerk; shall state the name and residence of the candidate. Each petition shall be filed in the office of the District Clerk between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Prevailing Time, not later than the Monday, May 11, 2020. Each person nominated is a candidate to fill any of the vacancies as described above.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN per the Executive Order No. 202.26 that the vote is now absentee ballots for all registered voters. The completed ballot must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m., June 9, 2020.

A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available in the office of the District Clerk on each of the five days prior to the day of the election, except Saturday and Sunday, during regular business hours.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Board of Education of the District will have prepared and completed a proposed

budget, specifically, a detailed statement in writing of the amount of money which will be required for the fiscal year 2020-2021 for school purposes, specifying the several purposes and the amount of each. The amount for each purpose estimated to be necessary for payment to the Board of Cooperative Educational Services shall be set forth in full with no deduction of estimated State aid. Such statement, together with the text of the resolutions to be voted on, will be available upon request to residents at District Office during the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Prevailing Time, weekdays, from May 26, 2020 to June 9, 2020 at each of the public schoolhouses of the District, on the District's website (www.grandislandschools.org), or at any public library or free association library within the District.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that additional propositions not requiring expenditures for the fiscal year 2020-2021 and the levying of taxes therefor must be submitted to the District Clerk, 1100 Ransom Road, Grand Island, New York, not later than 5:00 p.m., Prevailing Time on Monday, May 11, 2020. Such propositions will be presented with the proposed budget at the Budget Hearing. The School Board will not entertain any petition to place before the voters, any proposition for the purpose of which is not within the powers of the voters to determine, or any proposition which fails to include a specific appropriation where the expenditure of monies is required by the proposition.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that voting scanners will be used to record the vote on the budget, on all propositions, and on the election of members of the Board of Education.

LEGAL NOTICE PROCLAMATION EXTENDING LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE TOWN OF GRAND ISLAND JOHN C. WHITNEY, P.E. – TOWN SUPERVISOR

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, the World Health Organization designated the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, outbreak as a Public Health Emergency of International Concern;

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, United States Health and Human Services Secretary Alex M. Azar II declared a public health emergency for the entire United States to aid the nation's healthcare community in responding to COVID-19; WHEREAS, cases of COVID-19 have been documented in Erie County, and both travel-related cases and community contact transmission of COVID-19 have been documented in New York State and more are expected to continue;

WHEREAS, the Governor has declared a Disaster Emergency in the State of New York and the County Executive has declared a State of Emergency for Erie County; and;

WHEREAS, I previously declared a local state of emergency within the Town of Grand Island, effective on March 16, 2020 and April 15, 2020 and such proclamation was effective for a period of 30 days; and WHEREAS, the threat that COVID-19

poses to the health, safety, and welfare of the Town of Grand Island's residents and visitors continues, thus requiring the local state of emergency be continued for another 30 days;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John C. Whitney, Town Supervisor of the Town of Grand Island, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Laws of the State of New York, hereby find, pursuant to Section 24(1) of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, that there continues to be a public emergency in the Town of Grand Island and that the public safety is imperiled thereby, and hereby extend the March 16, 2020 and April 15, 2020 declaration of a local state of emergency

within the Town of Grand Island for an additional 30 days, effective immediately; IN ADDITION, this declaration shall remain in effect for another 30 days, unless earlier rescinded;

FURTHER, I hereby issue extend an emergency order that meetings of all advisory boards and the Zoning Board of Appeals, are hereby suspended until further Order, and, pursuant to Section 24(2) of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, this Order shall be in effect for five days, unless extended;

IN ADDITION, I hereby extend an emergency order that all public hearings before any board or body of the Town of Grand Island are hereby suspended and postponed, to be rescheduled at a date, time, and location to be determined and, pursuant to Section 24(2) of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, this Order shall be in effect for five days, unless extended;

IN ADDITION, I hereby extend an emergency order that public attendance at Town Board meetings is hereby suspended, and that any proceedings of the Town Board shall be made available via livestream or teleconference dial-in, with a link or call-in information posted on the Town of Grand Island website, pursuant to the Governor's Declaration of a Disaster Emergency, and, pursuant to Section 24(2) of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, this Order shall be in effect for five days, unless extended;

FURTHER, I hereby extend an emergency order that all laws providing for deadlines for action of any board are hereby tolled during the pendency of this State of Emergency, and, pursuant to Section 24(2) of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, this Order shall be in effect for five days, unless extended;

FURTHER, I hereby issue an emergency order that the issuance of all Hawking and Peddling licenses is suspended, to be resumed at a date, time, and location to be determined and, pursuant to Section 24(2) of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, this Order shall be in effect for five days, unless extended;

IN ADDITION, a copy of this Proclamation and the emergency orders herein shall be posted on the Town of Grand Island website, distributed to the media, and published in the official newspaper of the Town of Grand Island;

FURTHER, the Town is asking the public not to come to any Town facilities or offices for non-essential reasons and the Town is urging all community groups not to hold large public gatherings; and

IN ADDITION, additional emergency orders may be issued in light of further developments in responding to this disaster, pursuant to Section 24, Article 2-B of the Executive Law.
