Lewiston Christmas walk expands activities & dates

The annual Lewiston Christmas Walk weekend will take place Dec. 2-5 in the historic village. Center Street is full of holiday spirit! Many of the storefronts will offer special activities, treats, promotions and great shopping sales. Weekend activities start Thursday, Dec. 2, with the Holiday Market at the Brickyard Brewing Company, and conclude with the Lewiston Christmas Lights Parade at 5:30 p.m. Sunday, Dec. 5, on Center Street. Key events are as follows with a full schedule of events below.

Falls at Academy Park at 11:15 a.m. Santa will be in the Peace Garden from noon to 4 p.m. Activities in village continue through 4 p.m. **√ Sunday, Dec 5 – Shops are open!** Free carriage rides from 12:30-3:30 p.m. Center Street will close at 3:30 p.m. to accommodate the Lewiston Christmas Lights Parade, which starts at 5:30 p.m. Last year, the Christmas Walk weekend encouraged shopping, but without the activities and annual celebrations. This year, some of the activities and events are limited to keep everyone safe. “We are fortunate to be able to have many of our events that make the Christmas Walk weekend special held outside. Children can experience Santa, the petting zoo, sending letters to Santa and more outside,” said Jennifer Pauly, president of the Niagara River Region Chamber of Commerce. “The
