TNT celebrates Fall Expo



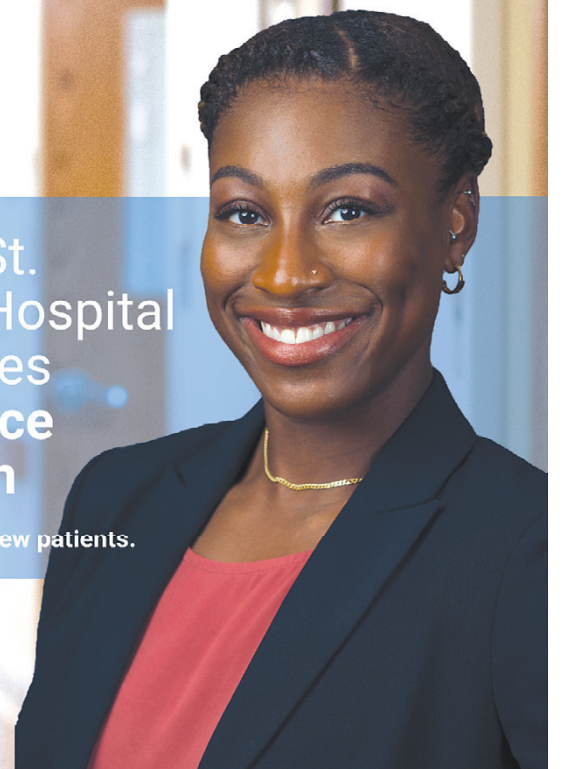
